Investigator of the Year

This recognition honors a law enforcement officer who demonstrates exceptional leadership and sustained commitment in the investigation of sex crimes. The recipient will have distinguished themselves through notable accomplishments such as innovative problem solving, strategic planning, organizational development, effective communication, and advanced investigative techniques. Nominees must show a significant, measurable impact on sex crimes investigations within their agency or jurisdiction, reflecting a high standard of dedication and excellence.

Department of the Year


This award honors a law enforcement agency that has demonstrated exceptional commitment, innovation, and effectiveness in the investigation and response to sex crimes. The recognized department will have shown leadership in developing best practices, fostering interagency collaboration, advancing training and education, and prioritizing victim-centered approaches. The recipient must exemplify organizational excellence and have made a measurable impact on sex crimes investigations and outcomes within their jurisdiction over the past year.

Civilian Partner of the Year

This recognition honors a civilian professional who has demonstrated outstanding leadership and sustained dedication in supporting the investigation of sex crimes. The recipient will have distinguished themselves through significant contributions such as innovative problem solving, strategic planning, organizational development, effective communication, or specialized expertise. Nominees must have made a meaningful impact within their agency or jurisdiction, advancing the response to, and investigation of sex crimes through their unique role and collaboration with law enforcement.

Career Achievement Award

This award honors a law enforcement officer whose distinguished career in sex crimes investigations is marked by exceptional accomplishments and lasting impact. Nominees should demonstrate a sustained commitment to the field through the length and depth of their investigative experience, handling of complex and high-profile cases, contributions to organizational development, and unwavering dedication to victims, their department, and the pursuit of justice. The recipient exemplifies expertise, professionalism, and leadership, serving not only as a skilled investigator but also as a mentor who actively supports and guides fellow officers in the investigation of sex crimes.
